Thank you for patiently waiting a whole year to participate in the St. Patrick Parade. We were so disappointed last year when just a day before the March 14, 2020 date our parade permit was pulled. We have been working with La Crosse County Board on the Covid requirements and just received our Parade Permit today from the City of La Crosse. Please check the La Crosse County Health Department websites for more information and updates as they may change before March 13th.

- Participants will line-up in the Freighthouse Parking Lot starting at 9:00am-11:00am. Maintaining a distance of 10ft between entries. Participants should also maintain social distancing. Parade will step off at noon. Traveling on 2nd St to Main. Going East on Main to 9th St.
- Masks are encouraged and should be worn during set up, in any inside space as well as along the parade route.
- Every entry should provide their group a hand sanitizing station.
- No interaction with attendees of the parade (no handouts or collections)

We will have further updates and details as we near the Saturday, March 13th date. Specifically, how we may be able to donate to The Hunger Task Force and the status of a post-parade get together.

We understand that this is an unusual year and your flexibility, understanding and compliance to keep our community safe is of utmost importance to our committee.
